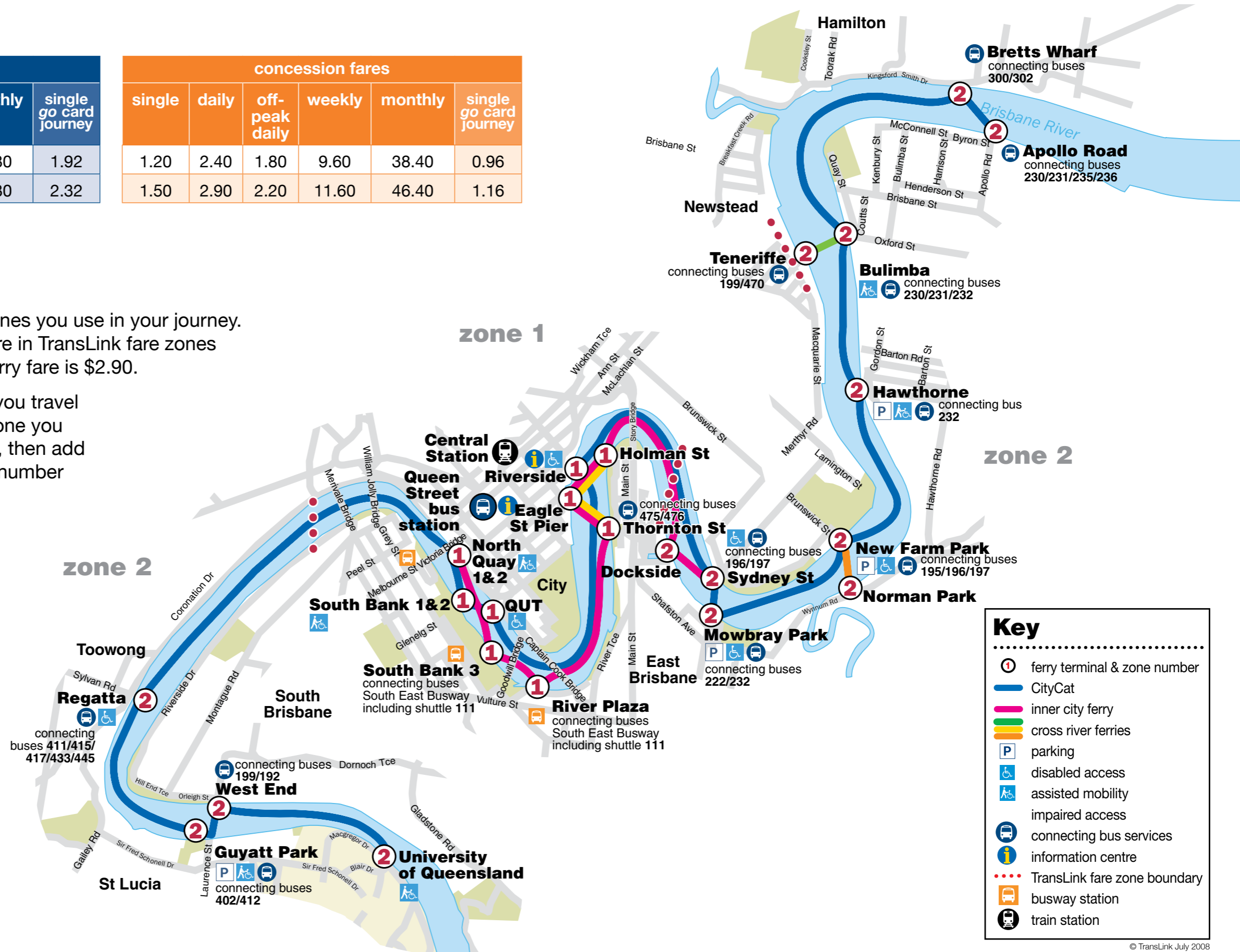
How to calculate fares

Fares are calculated on the number of zones you use in your journey. All Brisbane City Council ferry services are in TransLink fare zones 1 or 2. This means the maximum adult ferry fare is \$2.90.

To calculate your fare, look at the zones you travel in on your journey. Subtract the lowest zone you will be travelling in from the highest zone, then add one – this formula calculates the correct number of zones you will be using.

For example, if you are travelling from Bretts Wharf (zone 2) to QUT (zone 1), you are travelling through two zones (2-1+1 = 2) which is \$2.90 for an adult fare.

An example of an integrated trip is catching a train from Sunnybank (zone 4) or a bus from Eight Mile Plains busway station (zone 4) to South Bank (zone 1) and then a ferry to New Farm Park (zone 2). This is a four zone trip (4-1+1=4) and would cost \$3.80 for an adult fare.
